

In the Book of Samuel, David plans to do a great service for God, no less than to build a beautiful temple as a house of prayer. King David was an achiever who had accomplished a great deal. Yet Nathan says that God did not want the king to build the Temple. Rather, it was God who would do something for David; whereby David's descendants would lead God's people into the future. David had to let go of his great plans and learn to let God lead the course of his life.
