Our budget is meant to cover routine, everyday expenses of the church and the priest, such as utilities, salaries, and fringe benefits. The Repair and Maintenance budget is used to cover minor repairs and normal maintenance, such as lawn mowing, cleaning services, and our pest control contract.

Of course, the above figures do not include the special projects we are now doing, namely replacing the roof over the entire church building (\$67,200) and doing a major renovation of the rectory (\$86,500). We will have to have a separate campaign to build up our reserve account, which we have used to pay for these projects and is now almost depleted.
