How to use one check for multiple contributions or collections.

In order to write one check to cover multiple collections:

1. Make your check out as usual.
2. Take the envelopes that the check is covering and write the amount you are giving for each of the collections on each of their envelopes.
3. Total all of the amounts from the envelopes and make the check out for the total amount.
4. Place the check in an envelope with the collection envelopes the check covers.
5. On the front of the outer envelope, write your name, envelope number, and the total amount of the check.
6. The counters know to process this as a “split check”

St. Jude / Shrine Repair Projects Update

St. Jude:

Rectory - Jones Construction of Ivor was selected for the rectory work. Bid amount \$86,500.00, *Second Installment paid*. Electrician completed work, sub-floors are complete, Appliances delivered, Plumber is done and drywall is in progress. Next paint and floors. Estimated completion—September 20th.

Church:

Urinal in men's room not working.
Plumber contacted— temporary fix completed—part ordered for permanent fix.

Shrine:

Basement—Water is leaching in through all four walls. (Bid from JES accepted and approved by administrator, \$13,367.41, Paid in full—Completed) - Issue found on JES self inspection. Correction to be completed.)

Marble Steps up to Altar Cracked—Calls are being made to vendors for bids. (Bid in process)

Landscaping—Downspouts, French Drain, Grade Side yards for drainage issues , Transplant shrubs in beds add gravel. (Bid received from Schultz Landscaping - \$31,619.88—Bid approved—Deposit Paid work in progress)

Replace protective cover over round stained glass window over front door.—Lynchburg Stained Glass Bid accepted \$4,450.00—(Deposit Paid \$1,513) Repair stained Glass and add weather proofing cover.

Conversion to Heat-pump HVAC system-

Bid accepted from Conney's Heating & Air—2 Bosch 20 Seer Heat-Pumps—Removal of old system—\$26,721.88 (Completed and Paid in Full)

A Step in Time Chimney Sweep will be installing a new mortar crown on the chimney and putting up a stainless-steel chimney cap. This will all but eliminate the water that had been collecting at the bottom of the chimney. This is scheduled for the afternoon of 9/12 at a cost of \$1569.

Rectory Update as of 09/01/2022

Good afternoon!

It's been a busy week so far! The plumbers continue to work under the house to replace and connect everything in the kitchen and baths. Drywall work continues as well. The lower cabinets have been installed and the countertop company came out to create a template for their work. They said they will do their best to get the countertop to us as soon as possible, but did mention 3-6 weeks as a possibility as they are short-handed on labor. The floor refinisher is scheduled to begin Tuesday. That will keep the rest of the group out for a few days. We will send an update next week when we are all able to get back in the house and line up what's next, which will include drywall and primer, electrical work, upper cabinets, and bathroom assembly. We love the paint color you chose - that was our favorite option too! We have had significant supply chain issues with the bathroom vanities (we are now waiting for our 3rd attempt to be delivered). We are hopeful this will be resolved by this time next week. We continue to encourage (and beg) our subcontractors to make this project their priority.
