# How to use one check for multiple contributions or

## <u>collections.</u>

In order to write one check to cover multiple collections:

- 1. Make your check out as usual.
- 2. Take the envelopes that the check is covering and write the amount you are giving for each of the collections on each of their envelopes.
- 3. Total all of the amounts from the envelopes and make the check out for the total amount.
- 4. Place the check in an envelope with the collection envelopes the check covers.
- 5. On the front of the outer envelope, write your name, envelope number, and the total amount of the check.
- 6. The counters know to process this as a "split check"
