

A Word from our Financial Council

We started a new fiscal year on July 1. In preparation, during April and May the members of the Parish Finance Council developed a budget on how much we need to *spend* and therefore how much we need as *income* from the collections for the upcoming year. Unlike our federal government, we must "pay as we go" for all our expenses without borrowing the money. Here is what we expect to need in the next 12 months to keep our churches going, along with some comparisons to the fiscal year just finished.

For St. Jude Parishioners: You may remember that in late January, the Finance Council raised the weekly collection goal from \$2,500 to \$2,800 after a mid-year review of our fiscal status. Starting July 1, our new weekly goal is modestly increased to \$2,900. The monthly goal for the Repair and Maintenance collections remains the same at \$1,667.

For Shrine Parishioners: The weekly collection goal has been raised considerably from \$308 to \$462. The main reason for the increase is the Shrine needs to come closer to paying its fair share of the expenses for the Priest and the work done by the Administrative Assistant / Bookkeeper in the office. For our new budget, that "fair share" amount has been set at \$9,000 a year, or \$750 a month, which comes out to only around 8% of the total amount of budgeted line items that can reasonably be classified as "shared" expenses.

Expect to see more about our expenses in a future bulletin. Meanwhile, know that the Finance Council keeps in mind something similar to what we hear on PBS television: Our two churches are kept running because of contributions from parishioners like you. Thank you!
