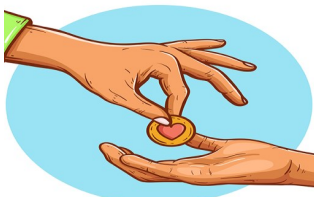

Social Ministry

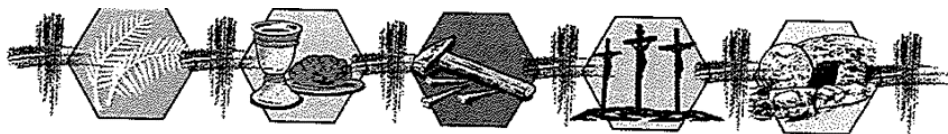

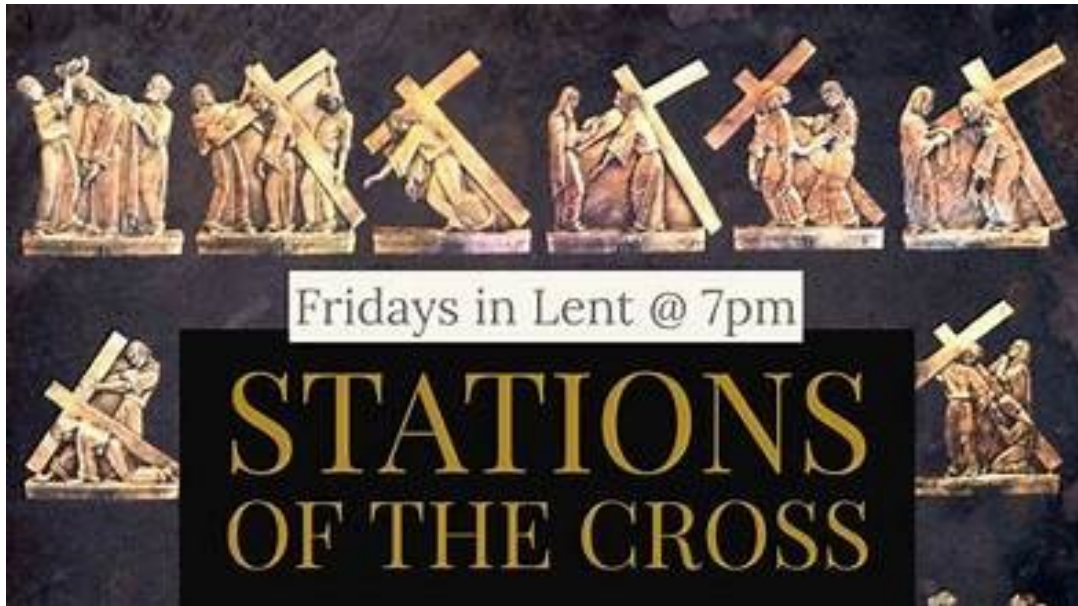
