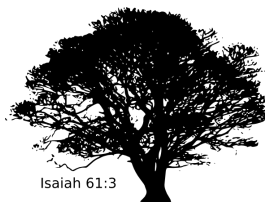

**FINANCIAL UPDATE:** We started a new fiscal year on July 1. In the bulletin insert today, you will find the budget for the new fiscal year on one side, and on the other side is a report on how we did in the year just ended for Regular Offertory Donations and the Repair and Maintenance Donations. These numbers show a \$13,584 and a \$6,175 shortfall respectively in those two major categories for St. Jude, and a \$1,436 shortfall for the Shrine Offertory.

In April and May, the members of the Parish Finance Council developed the new budget based on how much we need to *spend* and therefore how much we need as *income* from the collections for the upcoming year. Unlike our federal government, we must “pay as we go” for all our expenses without borrowing the money. Partly because of the recent inflationary environment, we had to raise our expected income to meet the expected expenses. Regular Offertory at St. Jude is raised from \$150,804 to \$155,000 (less than 3%). The Repair and Maintenance Collection is raised from \$20,000 to \$22,000 (or 10%). Therefore, our new *weekly* goal for the Regular Offertory is \$2,981 and the *monthly* goal for R&M is \$1,833. The Shrine’s Regular Offertory goal is reduced from \$24,000 to \$21,180 or \$407 per week.

**Special Collections:** Here are three local collections that fall in the Special Collections category, as follows:

- Haiti Missions (all collections that are received are forwarded to Haiti Missions)
- Social Ministry (all collections that are received are given to needy local people)

Confessional construction (a project that is not funded in our budget)

There are special envelopes in the Commons for these collections, and you can drop them in a collection basket on any Sunday. Please include your name on the envelope when donating.

The Special Collection figures include Legacy gifts, Haiti Ministry, Social Ministry, and grants from the Diocese such as Home Missions, Fuel and Hunger, and Respect Life. They also include the cluster reimbursement from the Shrine.

St. Jude R&M ordinary Expenses	\$ 22,000.00
Shrine Ordinary Expenses	\$ 28,690.00

The Expense figures include the monthly assessments for the Cathedraticum, insurance on the buildings, the Catholic Virginian, and Catholic schools. They Also include payroll, utilities, faith formation, parish life expenses such as plates, utensils, and food. R&M expenses include Terminix monthly pest control and annual termite inspections, janitorial service and lawn service. As well as unexpected repairs such as leaky toilets, repairs to air conditioner units and replacing light fixtures.

The Shrine expenses include the reimbursement to St. Jude for the shared personnel costs paid by St. Jude.
