

R&M EXPENSES INCLUDE TERMINIX MONTHLY PEST CONTROL AND ANNUAL TERMITE INSPECTIONS, JANITORIAL SERVICE AND LAWN SERVICE. AS WELL AS UNEXPECTED REPAIRS SUCH AS LEAKY TOILETS, REPAIRS TO AIR CONDITIONER UNITES AND REPLACING LIGHT FIXTURES.
