The Holy Father has announced that 2025 will be a Jubilee Year. This is something that happens every 25 years. The theme is *Pilgrims of Hope*, with an emphasis on a journey towards renewed hope in God.

One offering towards deepening our faith during this Jubilee is to undertake a pious pilgrimage. "According to the *Decree on the Granting of*

the Indulgence during the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025, the faithful pilgrims of hope will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence granted by the Holy Father if they undertake a pious pilgrimage" and participate in celebrations and devotions. Some of these are Holy Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, Rite of Penance, Rosary, and Way of the Cross. The Diocese of Richmond has designated 4 pilgrimage sites:

Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, Richmond

Basilica of Saint Mary, Norfolk

National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, Williamsburg

Basilica of Saint Andrew, Roanoke

There are also other National and International sites.

We can journey to these pilgrimage sites as individuals, or groups. Father thought it would be nice for us to go as a parish group, we could carpool together on a planned date. He is suggesting the Basilica in Norfolk. If you are interested in the group pilgrimage, we could begin planning the event after the Easter Season.
